PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL ITEMS ARE MARKED WITH FIRST AND LAST NAME

## Clothing

- 14 T-shirts
- 14 Pairs of shorts
- 5 Swimsuits
- Long sleeve rash guard (Recommended for sun protection)
- 14-16 Pairs of underwear
- 14 Pairs of socks
- 1 Rain coat
- 1 Long sleeve t-shirt or sweatshirt
- 1 Banquet outfit
  - Sea Gull: Polo shirt and nice shorts
  - Seafarer: Dress, skirt, nice shorts/pants and shirt
- 3-4 Pairs of pajamas
- 1 Pair of pants that can be worn in the river (Nylon, wind/rain pants, leggings, etc.)
- 1 Pair of closed-toe athletic shoes
- 1 Pair of flip flops
- 1 Pair of shoes that can be worn in the river
- 1 Official Camp shirt (Required. Available online or at the Camp Store on Opening Day)
  - Sea Gull: Camper Shirt
  - Seafarer: Middy

## Letter Writing Materials

- Pre-addressed, stamped envelopes (Please place in Ziploc bag to avoid moisture)
- Stationery
- Pens/pencils
- Black ballpoint pens

## Linens

- 2 Sets of twin sheets, 2 pillow cases
- 1 Pillow
- 1 Lightweight blanket/quilt
- 2 Bath towels and washcloths
- 2 Beach towels

- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Clip-on fan (Battery or electric)
- Combination lock for locker
- 2 Clothes hangers
- Crazy Creek chair (Available at the Camp Store)
- Blue & Green Books (Optional for returning campers)
- Goggles (Optional)
- US Coast Guard Approved life jacket (Optional)
- Seafarer horseback riders: ASTM-SEI approved helmet, riding boots, long pants

## Helpful hints and other optional items

- Mariners I and III include a special college night, so be sure to bring your favorite college gear!
- If you'll be at Camp on the Fourth of July, bring your red, white and blue.
- Packing in duffle bags/collapsible bags is recommended.
- Campers using special transportation home:
  - Bus:** allowed one bag and one carry-on (all other luggage must be shipped)
  - Domestic plane:** allowed one carry-on (all other luggage must be shipped)

## PLEASE LEAVE THESE THINGS AT HOME:

- ANY electronic device that has video capacity (NO cell phones, smart watches, iPads/tablets, computers, electronic games, digital cameras, GoPros, hotspots, etc.)
- iPod and MP3 players that may be damaged by heat
- Weapons/knives
- Tobacco, alcohol, drugs
- Food/candy
- Expensive items, jewelry, accessories
- Inappropriate books or magazines
- Cash
- Extra drawers/clothes storage
- Hanging storage for around bunk
- Fishing rods and tackle boxes
- Tower fans, A/C fans
